Call for abstracts – QSA CONVENTION

The use of photographs, figures and charts is encouraged in order to make the poster eye-catching.

The first author will present the poster (3 minutes, 3 slides) at the conference on Friday, May 17 at 11:15 pm. A maximum of 15 posters will be presented during the conference. A prize will be awarded for the best poster after the presentation.

THE TITLE MUST BE CAPITALIZED, SINGLE-SPACED AND IN BOLD. IT MUST BE VISUALLY STRIKING AND MUST NOT EXCEED FOUR LINES.

The body of the text must be clearly presented, in 12-point Arial or Helvetica font, regular style, 1.5-line spacing. The total length of the text (including the title and the origin of the work) must be no longer than this present format and contain no more than 250 words.

The abstract should be divided into 4 parts: 1) Introduction, including the goal of the work; 2) Description of the materials and methodology used; 3) Results; 4) Discussion and/or conclusion.

In the abstract itself, the use of charts and figures is not permitted unless absolutely necessary. Abbreviations are not allowed in the title but are permitted within the text if the same abbreviation is used three or more times.

Abstracts must be submitted in writing in the format provided for this purpose no later than Avril 1st, 2019.
